**Budget Concerns-** After last week's E-Board meeting, it is clear that we have serious financial concerns as an organization. We have to come up with a budget by February. We need to brainstorm ideas on how to get fees paid so we can work on a budget. We cannot continue to carry debt. We cannot plan a Spring Tour with people not having their outstanding fees paid for. We will have to let parents know that we cannot continue to carry fees. If students owe money, they will not be able to participate in future events until all fees are paid.

**IDEAS INCLUDE:**

- Emails, letters, show up at their doors?
- Get a team together to make phone calls to those with outstanding debt. Melinda will coordinate with those interested in helping this effort.
- Combine car wash with rummage sale- offer opportunity to students with debt to work off some of their debt by participating.
- Collect change- maybe have a competition between grade levels or sections to see who can raise the most change (coins) from now through May.
- Contact Alumni to see if they can donate to the Boosters
- Chris Zilar would like to contact Dan Harkins to see if he has an interest in helping Coronado. This is based on that Arcadia band program is in trouble, and some Arcadia band students may wish to join CHS Band program.
- Melinda will print out balance sheets for all students (even those with zero balance) and put them in envelopes. Doc. will pass out to all students and tell them they need to pay their fees.
- Doc will talk to Hayden School Supply to let them know fees need to be paid up front for shoes, gloves, etc. Boosters cannot pay up front and try to collect from students.
